



The Emerson Public Library strives to create a welcoming environment conducive to the safe and orderly use of the Library and requests the cooperation of patrons refraining from behavior that disrupts library services. All patrons of the Library, including children, are expected to abide by the Code of Conduct while using library materials and services, participating in library events, and programs, and other customary library business.

Children, like all library patrons, are expected to behave appropriately. Parents and caregivers, not library staff, are responsible for the behavior and supervision of their children in the library. Arrive early. Allow yourself time to hang up your coats, use the restroom and get ready for the program. Programs start promptly at their scheduled time.

We understand young children like to explore, but they should not prevent others from enjoying their program. We request that you encourage positive behaviors like good listening, following directions and being respectful of people and things in the room.

We want everyone to enjoy our programming. If your child's behavior (crying, running, scuffling, shouting or bothering performers), is affecting the enjoyment of others, please feel free to step out of the room briefly and return when they are ready. If behavior cannot be corrected, the child and supervising adult will be asked to leave the Library and not return.

There is plenty of time to socialize after the program is over and please keep your conversations for the end of the program.

Consider this a sharing time for you and your little one. Participate along with your child, they learn by watching you. Don't be afraid to look silly, they love it and it encourages them to participate as well!

Attend each class you registered for as space is limited. Please call the Library and notify the children's department if you will miss a class. If your child is not feeling well, please stay home and rest up!
